You will receive a tag that has a QR code upon it and provision to place your scooters information. If you have pre-registered your entry, this information will already be recorded.

When you register at the event, your rally pack will contain Show and Shine event labels for each entry that you submitted (if you pre-registered). If you didn't pre-register, we will ask you how many vespas you have in the competition and assign you the appropriate amount of labels to affix to your scooters.

On each of these labels will be a QR code and info about your Vespa (no names will appear on the QR code tags.) You must present your Vespa at the Ray Grace

Pavillion on Friday 28th March 2025, where judging will take place between the hours of 0300p and 0900p. Please affix your provided label to the handlebars of your Vespa using the provided rubber band and ensure the model and year information is correct.



At the Friday Night Festival, the general public can also use these QR codes to vote for the 'PEOPLES CHOICE' award. Your personal information will NOT be available on the tag, only your Vespa Year and Model.


Slow Ride Competition

The competition is setup in two categories for males and females. Three lanes are marked out over a distance of approximately 25 metres.

The heats commence with three riders attempting to be the last one over the finish line but be careful, putting your foot on the ground our going outside of your lane is instant elimination! Winners of each heat will receive a coloured token to present to the next round of elimination. Heats on Friday night with Finals happening on Saturday afternoon.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q. I am not a member of an affiliated Australian or Vespa World Club. Can I still attend and participate?
- **A.** Ticketing and participation for the event is now open to financial and non-financial members. That is gold, silver and bronze tickets can be purchased from both members and non-members. When purchasing tickets, simply select member or non-member to receive the applicable ticket pricing. All member ticket purchases will be validated.

You must be a member of a local Vespa Club in Australia to receive member ticketed pricing.

- Q. I do not need to camp for the full 3 nights at the rally location, can I just purchase 1 or 2 days only?
- A. The rally hub camping at Nambour Showgrounds has limited camping capacity and therefore camp sites have been optimised to provide a low cost accommodation solution covering the entire event (3 nights). Up to four adults can camp at each powered site (children U12 free) for a total cost of \$150.00. There are currently 50 campsites available. If demand is high for this type of accommodation, we are able to re-assess and open up a second oval if required.
- Q. How do I enter for the Show and Shine competition?
- **A.** When purchasing your AVD2025 GOLD or SILVER event ticket, simply email to admin@vespaclubbrisbane.com the following information:
 - i) Your name
 - ii) Your Vespa Year
 - iii) Your Vespa Model
 - iv) Attach a picture of your Vespa

We will then provide a printed label in your rally pack that you need to affix to your Vespa at the Friday Night Festival on Friday 29th March 2025 between the hours of 0300p and 0900p. This is when the judging will occur.

This is the only methodology used to enter, so we encourage all to submit their details. There will be no entry applications available over the actual event weekend.

- Q. I have special dietary needs for the Gala Dinner Event. How do I arrange this requirement?
- **A.** Please contact AVD 2025 organisers at <u>admin@vespaclubbrisbane.com</u> with your dietary needs with sufficient time prior to the event.

Q. Do I have to own a Vespa?

Yes, you must own a Piaggio Vespa to participate in the event ride outs and competitions.

Q. What transport options are there from the nearest airport to the event?

- Sunshine Coast Airport Transfers (Brisbane & Sunshine Coast Airports),
- Taxi's,
- Uber
- Hire / Rent Vehicles
- Train (Brisbane Airport Only)

Q. Are there other accommodation options besides camping?

Yes. Within a radius of 15 to 20 minutes drive, there is two star to five star accommodation available throughout the region.

Q. Can we hire a Vespa for the event?

Unfortunately, there are no scooter hire organisations that hire out Piaggio Vespa's in the region.

Q. What is the weather like at this time of year in Nambour?

The average temperature in the Nambour region towards the end of March has a high of 27 degrees Celsius and a low of 16 degrees Celsius or a range of 80 degrees to 60 degrees Fahrenheit.

Q. Will there be alcohol available at the venue?

The Australian Vespa Days Rally Hub is an alcohol free zone.

Q. What are the travel options to Nambour from Brisbane Airport?

It is approximately 103 km's from Brisbane Airport to Nambour. Train would be the most efficient option in getting there.

The Airtrain service is a privately owned rail operation and runs from Brisbane Airport first service at 05:04 am to last service at 10:04pm daily, Monday to Sunday. These services are at 30 minute intervals mostly with some additional services running during business hours.

To connect with a Nambour Train on the Brisbane Citytrain network, you must disembark from the Airtrain at Eagle Junction Station.

AVD Event Ride Ride Roles and Responsibilities

The organisers of the Australian Vespa Days Event are focused on delivering event rally rides that are fun, enjoyable and capture the Vespa riding experience. We want to achieve this with the safety of our members first and foremost in the front of our minds. Behind every awesome rally ride, we have a team of organisers prepared to deliver this experience. Below is their role during these rides.

As a group rider, please take the time to understand these roles and the part you play in making these rides not only enjoyable, but safe.

FIELD MARSHALL: The Field Marshall has the responsibility of ensuring that lost or broken down riders are retrieved from the ride and return

safely back to the Rally Hub. This is to ensure the LEAD RIDER does not have the worry of losing and retrieving riders in their

group thus breaking continuity of the ride. The Marshalls mobile phone number will be provided PRE rideout. If you lose

your way enroute and cannot recover or break down please notify your Field Marshall.

LEAD RIDER: Lead Riders are distinguished by their **Fluoro Yellow Vests** and will lead the group ride travelling at safe prescribed road

speeds. They are responsible for tracking the journey and using the drop marker system to guide the group to its destination.

MID RIDER: Mid Riders are distinguished by their Fluoro Yellow Vests and will ride mid pack within a LARGE ride group. They are

responsible for contacting the Lead and Tail riders where possible to ensure continuity in the group. Mid Riders provide a

large group with visibility of the ride organisation is intact whilst on the journey.

TAIL RIDER: Tail Riders are distinguished by their **Fluoro Yellow Vests** and will tail the group ride travelling at safe prescribed road

speeds. They are responsible for maintaining the rear of the group whilst riding ensuring no body falls behind.

COMPETENT FIRST AIDER: A rider within the group who is competent in first aid. They will be distinguished by their Fluoro Yellow Vest and will ride

with the Tail Rider at the back of the group.

BREAKDOWN VEHICLE: A vehicle on standby at the Rally Hub capable of retrieving broken down riders.

The Mary Valley Rattler

As we leave Nambour Showgrounds, we head to Yandina famous for the Ginger Factory and awesome coffee shops. Then onto the town of Eumundi and its famous markets which we go past on the way down. Then onto Eumundi Range Road with spectacular views of the valleys below and ,mountain ranges, then through the small town of Cooroy and onto great windey roads to the small village of Pomona, Cooran and Traveston where we stop for fuel at the Matilda Service Station about 75 kms from Nambour. RIDE 6 - The Presidents Cavalcade Farewell Ride




